Transportation Information

Mission Heights Preparatory High School provides bus transportation for students who live in Casa Grande, Arizona City, Eloy, and Toltec. Please read through all the information in the packet to understand what services we provide and on what conditions we provide that service.

Obtaining transportation services from Mission Heights is a two-step process:

1. Download and log in to the Cariina-Parent app on your smartphone (instructions are on the reverse side of this page).
2. Fill out the Transportation Request Form and return it to the school. Make sure you review the MHP Bus Rules on the reverse side of that document before turning it in.

Your student will not be allowed to ride the bus until both of these steps have been completed.

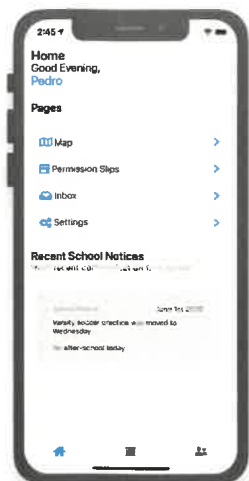
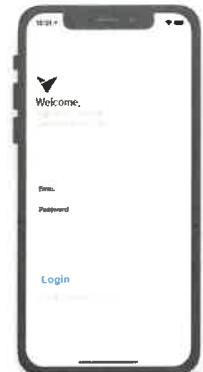

MHP Bus Rules

Make sure you are at your bus stop 10 minutes early.

ALL MHP SCHOOL RULES, POLICIES, & PROCEDURES APPLY WHILE RIDING THE BUS, including:

- Show your Student ID when getting on/off the bus
- Get on/off the bus at your assigned stop (unless you have a special pass from Admin)
- You must have a green “MHP P4 Bus Pass” to ride the P4 Bus.
- Respect the driver, other passengers, and their property.
- Follow all directions.
- Seats may be assigned by the bus driver.
- Keep all parts of your body inside the bus at all times.
- Keep all parts of your body out of the aiseways.
- Students should talk quietly and keep their hands to themselves.
- Absolutely NO FIGHTING.
- Be courteous of those around you. No profanity, or obscene gestures.
- No eating, chewing gum, or drinking. (Except water)
- No littering or destruction of the bus.
- Keep your personal belongings under control at all times.
- Students are responsible for any damage they cause to the bus.
- Nothing is to be thrown outside of the bus.
- Students are not allowed to bring balloons or skateboards on the bus.
- Students are to remain in their seats until the bus comes to a complete stop.
- Headphones/Earbuds must be removed when getting on/off the bus.

****If a student does not ride the bus for 5 consecutive days, they risk losing their bus riding privileges and their stop may be removed from the route.***

****The administrative team reserves the right to deny bus privileges to any student.***

MHP COVID-19 Bus Rules

While COVID-19 Restrictions are in place, we ask that you follow these additional rules:

- Do not ride the bus if you are experiencing any of the symptoms related to COVID-19 or if you have been exposed to it within the last 14 days.
- Students must wear a mask while entering, riding, and exiting the bus.
- Students must sanitize their hands as they get on and off the bus. A pump bottle will be available in the entry of the bus.
- Students must sit one person per seat unless they are siblings.
- Students should fill from the back of the bus to the front of the bus and then exit the bus from the front to the back. This will minimize students passing each other.
